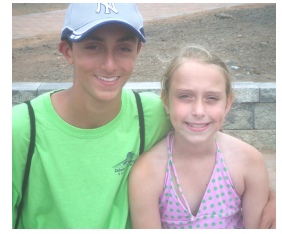


Counselor-In-Training Program

Teenagers aged fourteen and fifteen can participate in our CIT (counselor-in-training) program, where teens will be instructed on becoming counselors and aid in counselor duties. The CIT program encompasses leadership skills, as well as focusing on problem solving and developing teaching abilities. A CIT acts as a role model for campers to follow, and becomes well-prepared for possible future counseling positions.



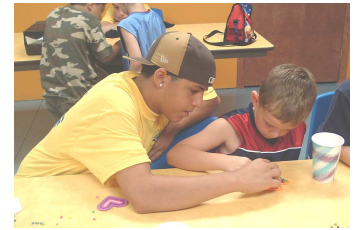
CIT positions are available per week, throughout all nine weeks of camp (8:30 am - 4:00 pm Monday through Friday), are cost-free, and lunch is provided free of charge. Teens will also obtain community service hours upon completion. CIT positions are competitive, and all potential counselors-in-training must participate in a short interview to evaluate true interest in the program before being accepted. Interviews will take place during the month of May and June. Teenagers will be notified by phone after their application is received when this interview will be held. At the interview, the weeks of camp desired will also be discussed.

In addition to coming to all five days of camp the week registered, **all teens (as well as counselors) must attend a mandatory training session held at the CT Sportsplex on Thursday, June 9, 2016, from 4-6 pm.**

Finally, since a CIT is a role model that campers look up to, it is important that a CIT understands their responsibility as a resource for campers and an authority figure, and acts appropriately while at camp. Professionalism is a highly valued attribute in CIT candidates, and CIT's must reflect this in order to truly fulfill this position.



Registration forms for CIT positions can be accepted until June 1st. As with campers, **health forms are also required for CIT's.**
